

At Arisaig, and within Arisaig Parish Church, the eighth day of September 2006, at 6.45 pm, which place, date and time the Presbytery of Lochaber met in hunc effectum and was constituted with prayer.

**1. SEDERUNT, APOLOGIES & WELCOME**

Present were Mr John Fraser, Moderator, the Rev David M. Anderson, Clerk, sixteen full members and two corresponding members of Presbytery. Names and apologies as per sederunt sheet. Associated with Presbytery were Ann Lyall DCS President of the Diaconate Council, Helen Hughes DCS, Valarie Duff DCS, Muriel Wilson DCS, Morag Crawford DCS, Kenneth MacKay DCS, John Craw DCS and Suzie Stark Ministries Support Officer at the Ministries Council.

**2. MINUTE & EDICT**

That part of the minute of the meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> September 2006 appointing this day and place for the Ordination of Miss Janet Anderson DCS to the office of Deacon of the Church of Scotland and Introducing her as Deacon and Parish Assistant to the charge of Arisaig & the Small Isles linked with Mallaig St. Columba's with Knoydart having been read, the Clerk intimated that the Edict had been duly served before the assembled congregation and that no one had appeared to object to the life or doctrine of Miss Janet Anderson.

**3. ORDINATION & INTRODUCTION**

The Presbytery then proceeded to the Church, where the Moderator conducted worship and the Rev Dr Richard Corbett preached.

The Moderator then addressed to Miss Anderson the Questions appointed to be put on Ordination to office of Deacon and received satisfactory answers to the same. The Formula having been signed, the Presbytery did, by prayer with the imposition of hands, ordain the said Miss Janet Anderson to the office of Deacon and introduced her to the charge of Arisaig & the Small Isles linked with Mallaig St. Columba's with Knoydart. Prayer being ended the Rev Dr Richard Corbett, addressing Miss Anderson in terms of the prescribed form, declared her to be Ordained to the office of Deacon. The Moderator gave her the right hand of fellowship as did other members of Presbytery present. Miss Anderson was suitably addressed by Miss Ann Lyall DCS who also in appropriate terms exhorted the congregation. After praise and prayer, the congregation was dismissed, an opportunity being afforded them to meet Miss Anderson.

**4. ROLL**

The Presbytery resumed alone. The name of Miss Janet Anderson DCS was added to the Roll of Members and the Clerk thanked the participants in the service.
