

At Fort William, and within the Hall of Fort William Duncansburgh MacIntosh Parish Church, the second day of September 2007, at 6.15 pm, which place, date and time the Presbytery of Lochaber met *in hunc effectum* and was constituted with prayer.

1. SEDERUNT, APOLOGIES & WELCOME

- 1.1 Present were the Rev A. Ann Winning, Moderator, the Rev David M. Anderson, Clerk, plus twenty full members and three corresponding members of Presbytery.
- 1.2 Names and apologies as per sederunt sheet.
- 1.3 The Moderator welcomed all present.
- 1.4 Associated with Presbytery was Father Roddy Johnston.

2. MINUTES

- The Clerk read the two relevant sections of the minutes of Presbytery: -
- 2.1 Section Four of the minute of the Presbytery Meeting on 1st May 2007 where Presbytery agreed to the Union of Fort William Duncansburgh and Fort William MacIntosh Memorial to form the new charge of Fort William Duncansburgh MacIntosh;
 - 2.2 Section 8.6 of the minute of the Presbytery Meeting on 5th June 2007 where this day and time was appointed for the Service of Union.

3. SERVICE OF UNION

The Presbytery then proceeded to the Church where the Moderator conducted and preached. The Clerk gave a narrative of the steps leading to the union. Members of both congregations signified their assent to the union by standing. The Rev Donald MacQuarrie reaffirmed his adherence to the vows taken on 24th August 1990 on the occasion of his induction to the charge of Fort William Duncansburgh linked with Kilmonivaig. The Formula having been signed, the Moderator Installed the Rev Donald MacQuarrie as minister of the united charge of Fort William Duncansburgh MacIntosh. The Moderator then invited the newly united congregation to welcome Mr MacQuarrie in this new sphere of service and to recognise this new relationship by applauding. The congregation applauded. The Service ended with prayer led by the Rev Donald MacQuarrie, with praise and with the Benediction at 7.35 pm.

Presbytery adjourned to meet for ordinary business on Tuesday 4th September 2007 in Kilmallie Parish Church, Caol, at 6.00 pm.
